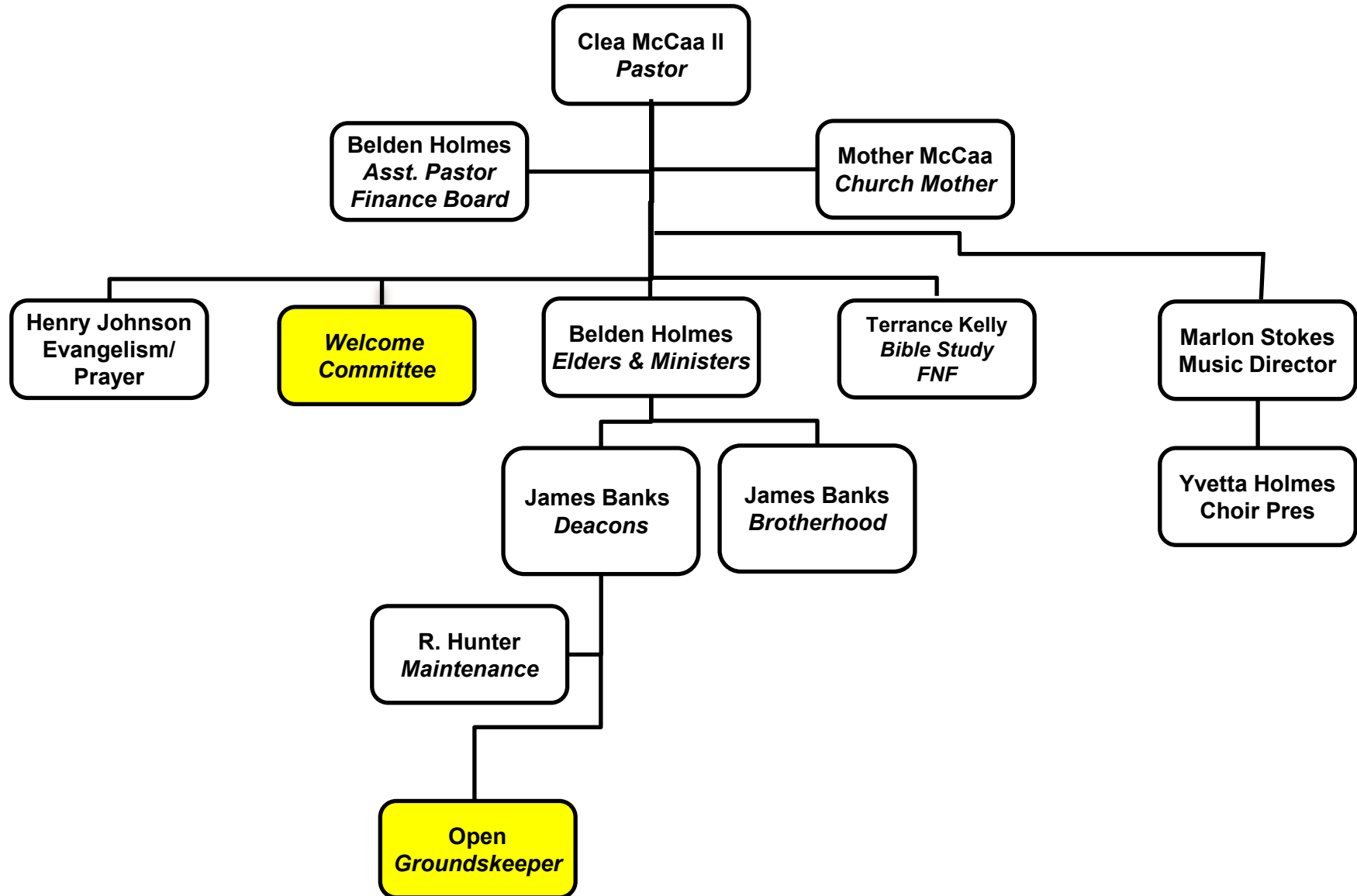

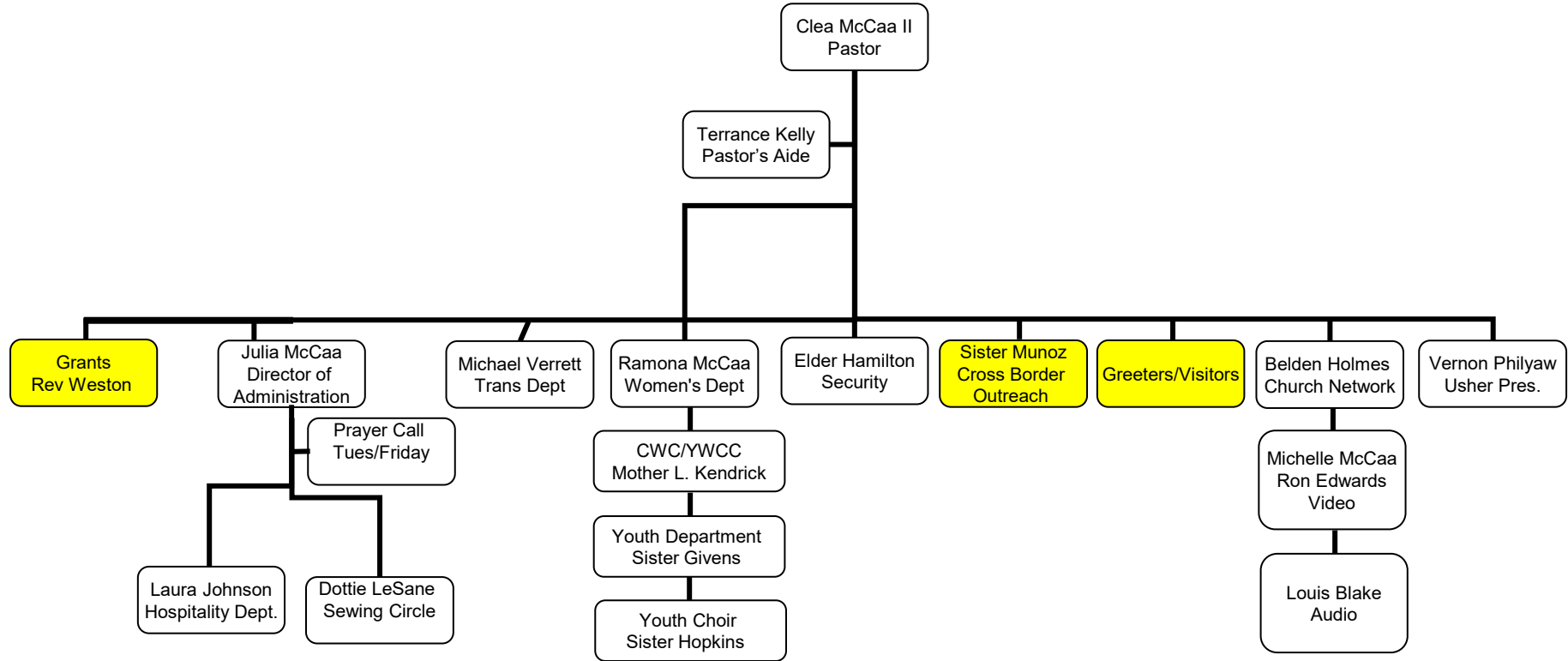


ORGANIZATIONAL CHART

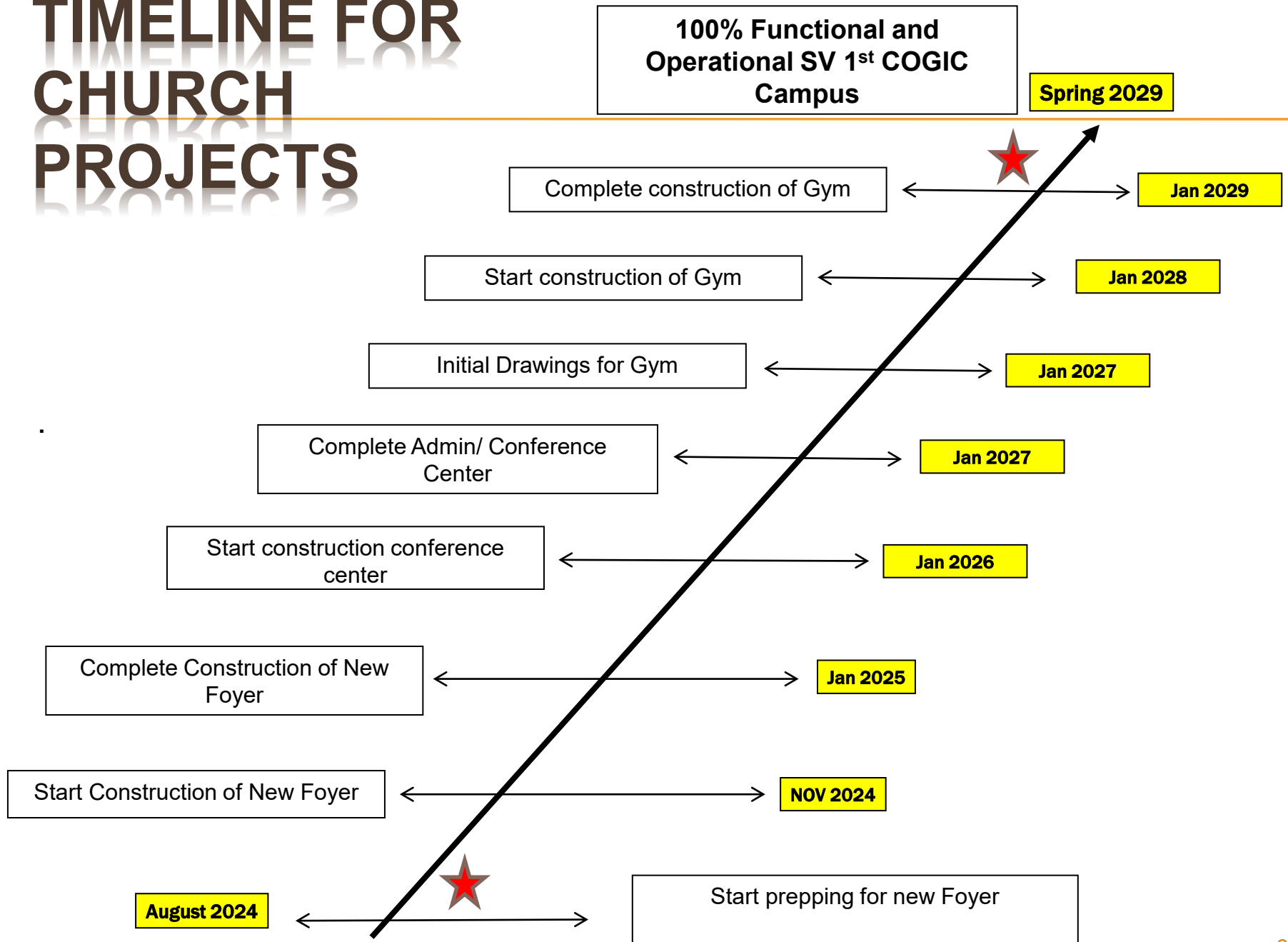




ORGANIZATIONAL CHART

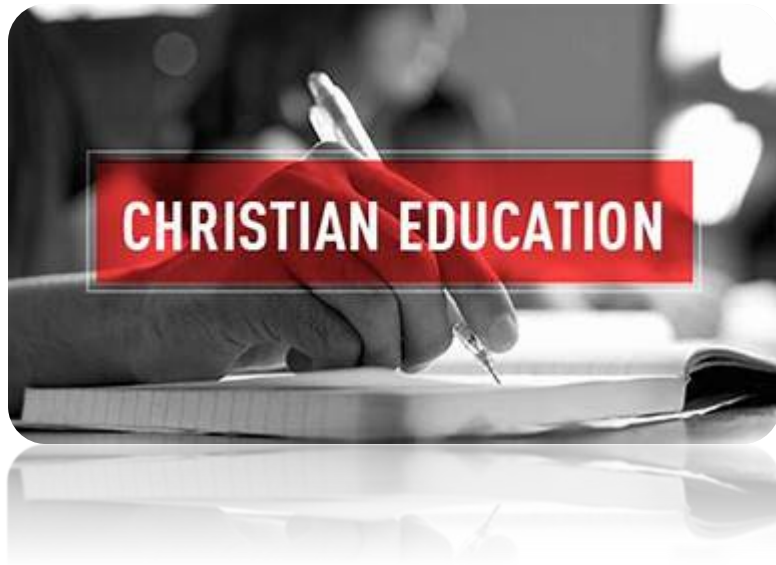

SECURITY

- **Patrol and Surveillance:** Responsible for monitoring the church premises, identifying potential security risks, and ensuring the safety of congregants.
- **Emergency Response:** Trained to handle various emergency situations, including medical emergencies (nursing staff), natural disasters – Storms or any violent incidents.
- **Communication and Coordination:** Maintain effective communication systems and coordinating the team's efforts during events or emergencies.

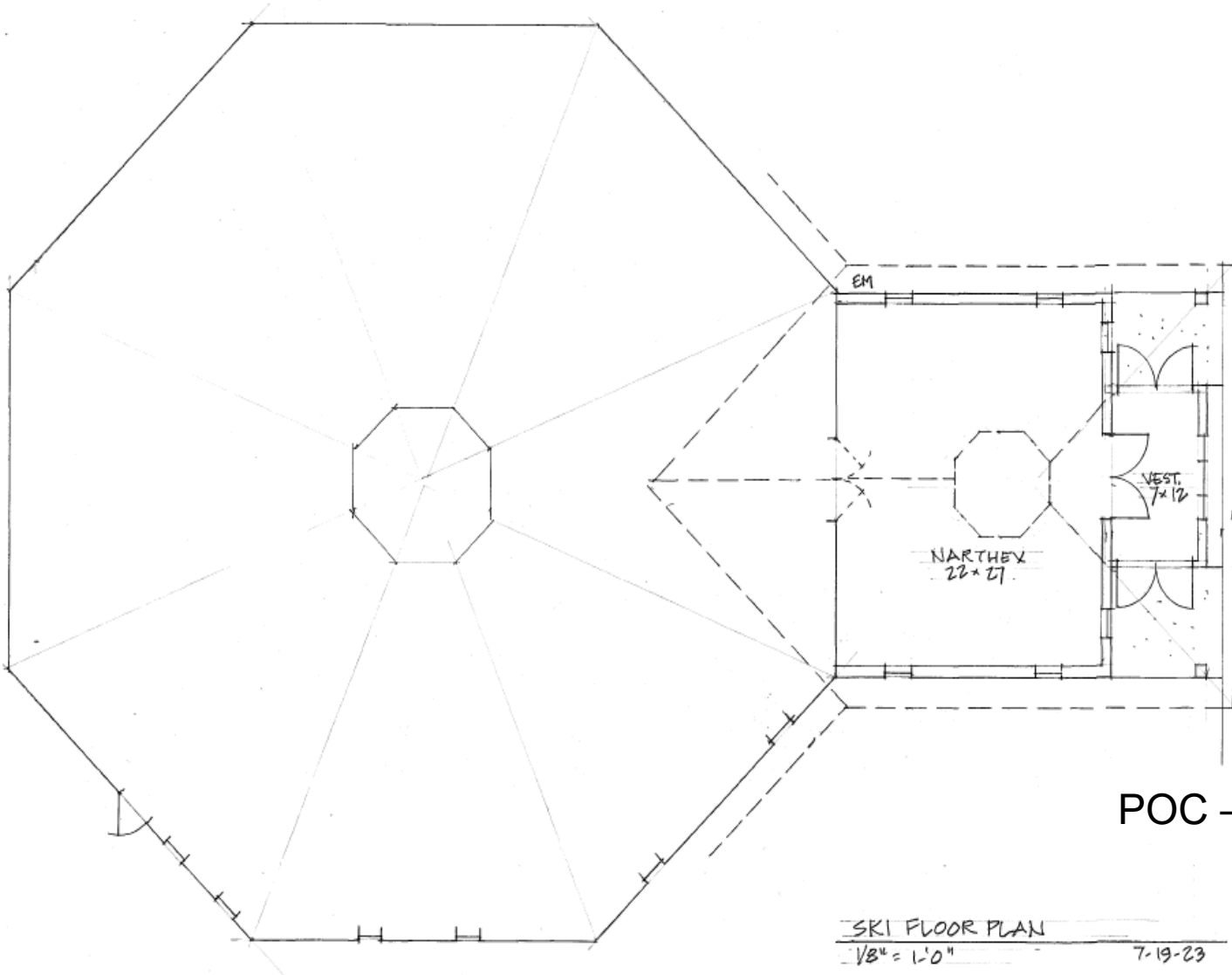

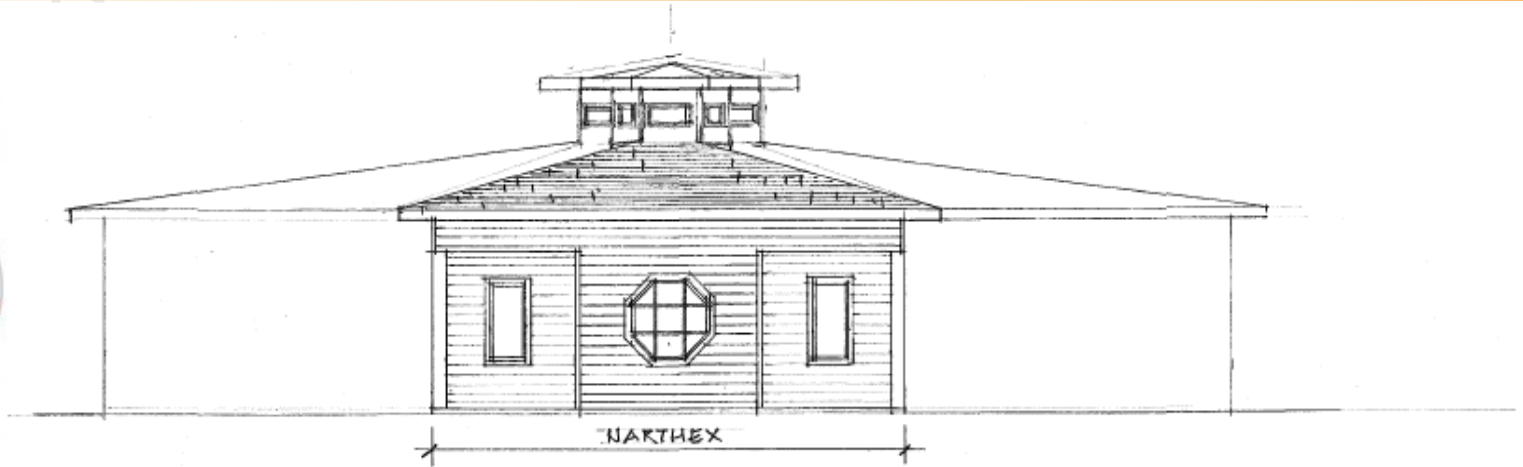
SKI FLOOR PLAN

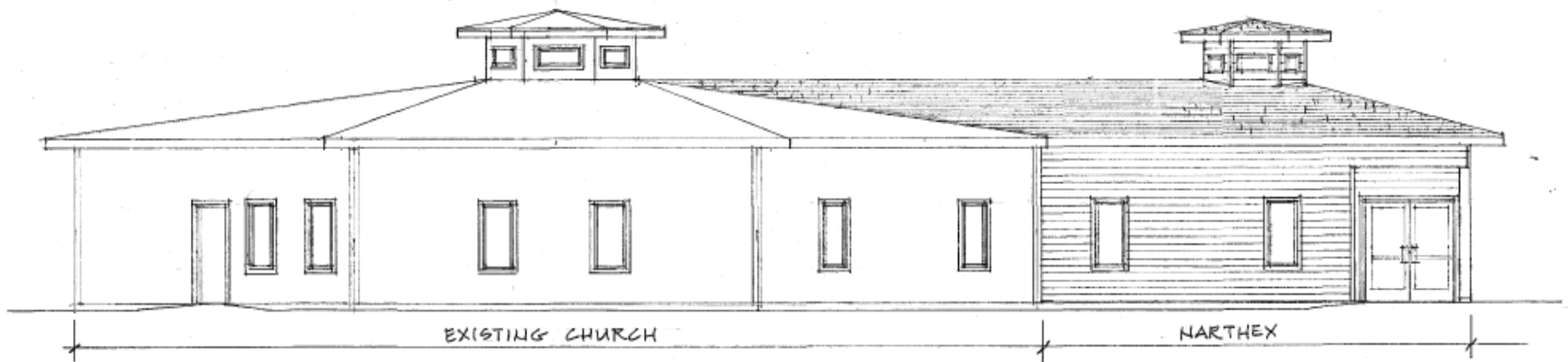

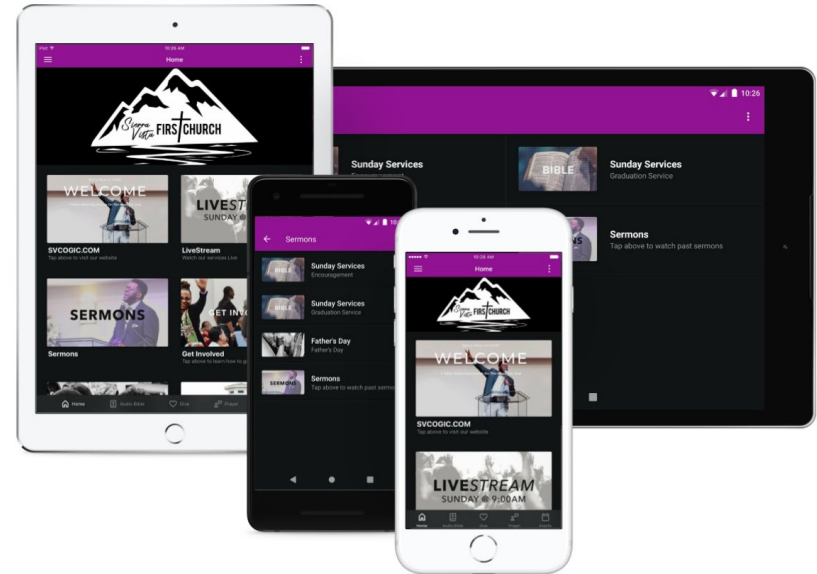

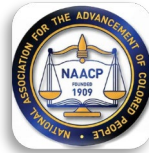
